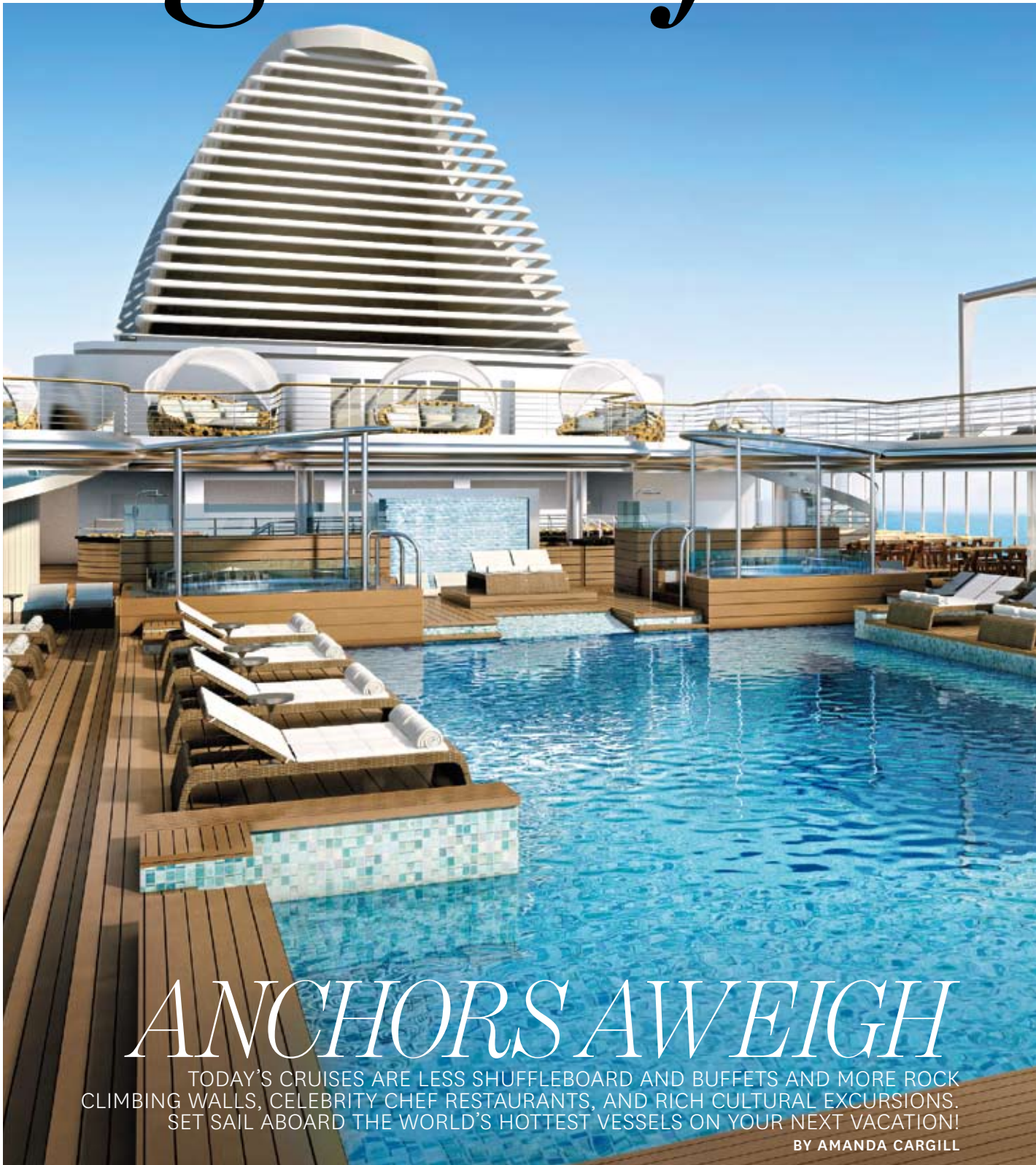

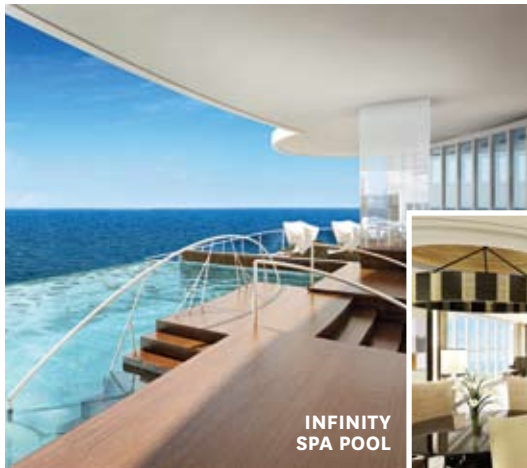
SEVEN SEAS EXPLORER
